RRB NTPC 1st Stage Exam is going to be conducted on 15th December 2020. All the eligible candidates should know what is the pattern and what is the total number of marks allotted for each subject. By knowing the pattern the candidates can prepare strategically, RRB(Railway Recruitment Board) will conduct NTPC(Non-Technical Popular Category) to recruit the candidates for posts Goods Guard, Senior Clerk cum Typist, Junior Clerk cum Typist, Assistant Station Master, etc. The candidates who will attend the RRB NTPC exam should know the pattern and marking scheme of the examination. There is a negative marking of ½ mark, to be deducted for every wrong answer. To get the complete details regarding the RRB NTPC Pattern 2020 go through the article.

RRB NTPC Exam Pattern 2020

The candidates will undergo 4 stages of the selection process. 1st Stage CBT examination, 2nd Stage CBT examination, Computer Based Aptitude Test/Typing Test, Document verification. Below are the patterns for the 1st Stage CBT examination and 2nd Stage CBT examination.

RRB NTPC 1st Stage CBT Exam Pattern 2020

Below is the pattern of the 1st Stage CBT examination.

- The Total questions asked in the RRB NTPC 1st Stage Exam are 100.
- The RRB NTPC Exam is conducted for 100 marks.
- Each question carries 1 mark.
- Marks deducted for every wrong answer is \(\frac{1}{3} \).
- The duration of the RRB NTPC 1st Stage CBT Exam is 90 Minutes.
- The duration of the RRB NTPC 1st Stage CBT Exam for the PWD exam is 120 minutes.

Note- The minimum percentage of marks to qualify in the examination is: UR-40%, EWS- 40% OBC-30%, SC- 30%, ST- 25%

RRB NTPC 2nd Stage CBT Exam Pattern 2020

The candidates will be shortlisted in the ratio of 1:20 times the vacancies of the category. The shortlisting is based on the performance of the candidates in the 1st stage of the CBT exam.

- The Total questions asked in the RRB NTPC 2nd Stage CBT Exam are 120.
- The RRB NTPC Exam is conducted for 120 marks.
- Each question carries 1 mark.
- Marks deducted for every wrong answer is \(\frac{1}{3} \).
- The duration of the RRB NTPC 2nd Stage CBT Exam is 90 Minutes.
- The duration of the RRB NTPC 2nd Stage CBT for the PWD exam is 120 minutes.

Note- The minimum percentage of marks to qualify in the examination is : UR-40%, EWS- 40% OBC-30%, SC- 30%, ST- 25%

Computer-Based Aptitude Test (Only for Candidates who Opted the Post-Traffic Assistant and Station Master)

The candidates who applied for post Traffic assistant and station master will have Computer Based Aptitude Test. The candidates will be shortlisted 8 times the vacancies of the category. The candidates are shortlisted for

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CBAT on the basis of marks obtained in the 2nd Stage of the CBT Exam. The candidates scoring at least 70% of marks in the 2nd Stage and 30% of marks in the CBAT examination will be considered in the merit list.

Typing Skill Test (TST)

Typing skill test is conducted for Senior Clerk Cum Typist, Senior Time Keeper, Accounts Clerk, Junior Time Keeper, Junior Clerk Cum typist. The typing Skill test is Qualifying in nature. The candidate should type at least 30 WPM in English of 25 WPM in Hindi on a personal computer only. Without any editing tools.

Language	Speed of Typing
English	30 Words Per Minute
Hindi	25 Words Per Minutes

Note:

- Typing Skill Test is qualifying in nature.
- For candidates who are giving the typing test in Hindi, Kruti Dev, and Mangal, the font will be made available for the candidates on their personal computer during the exam.
- For candidates who have a disability of boundlessness or low vision of not less than 40% will have to get a certificate issued from the Competent Medical Board and for such candidates, the merit will be based on the 2nd stage of CBT.

RRB NTPC Document Verification 2020

The candidates will be called for the document verification based on their performance in the 2nd stage CBT exam. The candidates who miss the Document verification will not be considered for the Merit list. The candidates need to show the original documents like SSC Marksheet, Minimum educational qualification certificate, Experience Certificates(if any), Category Certificate, etc. Below are the documents needed to produced by the candidates

- Matriculation/High School certificate or it's equivalent for the proof of Date of birth.
- The +2/Inter/Graduation Certificate.
- Category Certificate for SC/ST/OBC Candidates.
- Jammu and Kashmir Domicile Certificate, if applicable.
- Self-declaration certificate by the Transgender.
- Death Certificate of the husband for the widow candidates.
- NOC Certificate for the serving employees and Defence Personnel(Ex-Servicemen).
- Income Certificate for EWS candidates.

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
