- i. 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
- ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
- iii. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
- iii. Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.

The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status.

The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years.

**The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority**. The Income and Asset Certificate issued from 01.04.2023 to 05.02.2024 by prescribed authorities in the prescribed format shall only be accepted as proof of candidate's claim as belonging to EWS.

The crucial date for submitting the income and asset certificate shall be the closing date for submission of applications. The Institute shall verify the veracity of the Income and Asset certificate submitted by the candidate. If a candidate gets appointment on the basis of false claim of EWS, his/her services shall be terminated without assigning any further reasons and without prejudice to such further action as may be taken under provisions of the Indian Penal Code of fake/ false certificate. Candidates may also note in respect of the above that their candidature will remain provisional till the veracity of the concerned document is verified by the Appointing Authority.

Where any vacancy earmarked for EWS cannot be filled up due to non-availability of a suitable candidate belonging to EWS, such vacancies shall not be carried forward to the next recruitment year as backlog. Hence, other category candidates are also allowed provisionally to apply for EWS posts as UR candidate subject to condition that they will be considered for EWS posts as UR candidate only if EWS category seat is otherwise not filled. However, there shall be no relaxations available which are otherwise permitted under their specific categories.
