

A. Essential Educational Qualifications and Experience.

(I) (a) For Teaching Faculty Mentioned at S.No.1 to 4 and 6 to 16 above (Except S.No.05)

- (1) A recognized medical qualification included in the First or Second Schedule or Part II of the Third Schedule (other than licentiate qualifications) to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. Holders of Educational qualifications included in Part II of the Third Schedule should also fulfill the conditions stipulated in sub-section (3) of section 13 of the India Medical Council Act, 1956.
- (2) Post- Graduate Degree in the concerned specialty/super specialty mentioned in Section-A of Schedule VI or equivalent i.e. DNB in Concerned Specialty/super specialty of the CHS Rule, 1996.
- (3) At least three (3) years teaching experience in the concerned specialty as Lecturer/Tutor/Registrar Demonstrator/Sr. Resident after the requisite Post-graduate degree qualification. (Note:- Teaching experience in any other post like the posts of GDMO/Medical Officer shall not be considered for eligibility purpose for recruitment to teaching posts.)
- (4) In case of super Specialty disciplines in addition to requirement at (I) to (IV) above, at least 3 years experience as Senior Resident/Tutor/Demonstrator /Registrar /Lecturer in the concerned specialty in a recognized Teaching Institution after the first postgraduate qualification (Note:- In the case of holders of D.M./M.CH. qualification of five years duration, the period of senior PG residency rendered in the last Part of the said D.M./M.CH. shall be counted towards requirement of five years' experience).
- (5) In disciplines where there are no prescribed CHS regulations, the minimum education qualification and experience to be prescribed shall be drawn on the line similar to the standard prescription in the CHS regulations of other specialties and in consultation with the HOD of the concerned Department Of MAMC/ other Institutions.
- (6) The candidate must be registered with Delhi Medical Council before appointment to the post.

- (I) (b) **Age:-** Not exceeding **40 Years** as on date of Interview. (Age relaxation as per applicable Govt. guidelines)

(II) (a) Essential Qualification and Experience for the post at S.No.5 above.

- (1) Master's degree in Psychology or equivalent from a recognized University.
- (2) M. Phill. Or Diploma in medical & Social Psychology or equivalent from a recognized University.
- (3) Two years teaching experience in Clinical Psychology including experience as a Clinical Psychologist in a Psychiatry Hospital, Clinic or Child Guidance Clinic.

(II)(b) Desirable:-

- (1) Doctorate Degree in Clinical Psychology or Anthropology or Social Psychology.
- (2) Experience in individual and group Psychotherapy and counselling techniques.

(II) © Age Limit:-

Not exceeding 35 years as on date of Interview. (Age relaxation as per applicable Govt. guidelines)


B. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACTUAL APPOINTMENT

- I. The appointment is purely on contract basis for a period of one year or till the regular incumbent joins or till further orders, whichever is earlier with effect from the date of joining. Thereafter, the contract will lapse automatically. The appointment can also be terminated at any time on either side by giving one month's notice or by paying one month's salary, without assigning any reason or failure to complete the period of three month's to the satisfaction of the competent authority.
- II. The consolidated remuneration will be:-
 - (1) Rs.1,23,500/- per month for the post Mentioned at S.No.1 to 4 and 6 to 16 above.
 - (2) Rs.56,100/- pm plus DA only i.e. at the entry level in PB3 level-10 as per 7th Pay Commission for the post Mentioned at S.No.5 above.

- III. The appointee shall perform the duties assigned to him/her. The Competent authority reserves the right to assign any duty as and when required. No extra/additional allowance will be admissible in case of such assignment.
- IV. The appointee shall not be entitled to any benefit like Provident Fund, Pension, Gratuity, Medical Attendance Treatment, Seniority, Promotion etc. or any other benefits available to the Government Servants appointed on regular basis.
- V. Non-practicing Allowance will not be admissible.
- VI. The appointee will not be granted any claim or right for regular appointment to any post under Central Health Service.
- VII. The appointee shall be on the whole time appointment of the Institution and shall not accept any other appointment, paid or otherwise and shall not engage himself/herself in private practice of any kind during the period of contract.
- VIII. The appointment carries with it the liability to serve in any part of the country.
- IX. The appointment to the said post will be subject to physical fitness from the competent medical board for which he/she will be sent to the designated Medical Authority by the concerned Institution/ Hospital before joining the post.
- X. The appointee is required to submit a declaration regarding his/her marital status in the enclosed proforma.
- XI. The leave entitlement of the appointee shall be governed in terms of instructions contained in DOPT OM No. 12016/3/84-Estt.(L), dated the 12, April, 1985, as amended by OM No. 12016/1/96-Estt. (L) dated the 5th July, 1990.
- XII. On appointment, the appointee will be required to take an oath of allegiance to the Constitution of India or make a solemn affirmation to that affect in the prescribed proforma.
- XIII. The appointee is not entitled to any TA for joining the appointment.
- XIV. Other conditions of service will be governed by relevant rules and orders issued from time to time.
- XV. If any declaration given or information furnished by him/her proves to be false or if he/she is found to have willfully suppressed any material information, he/she will be liable for removal from service and also such other action as the Government may deem necessary.
- XVI. The candidate must fulfill the requisite qualification and experience on or before the date of Interview.
- XVII. Persons with disability are encouraged to apply.
- XVIII. Female candidates with requisite qualification are encouraged to apply.
- XIX. **The candidates belonging to OBC category must produce the latest OBC-Non Creamy Layer Certificate issued from Govt. of NCT of Delhi.**

The eligible and desirous candidates fulfilling educational qualifications/eligibility conditions should appear for a Walk-in-Interview with their application form along with Original Certificates and one set of self attested photocopies of the relevant documents in support of Age, Qualification, Mark sheet, Degree, Category, Experience & Three passport size photographs and a Demand Draft of Rs. 1000/- for UR/OBC/EWS and Rs. 300/- for SC/ST candidates (Non Refundable) payable at Delhi/ New Delhi (issued by the Bank after the date of publication of Notice) in favour of "**DEAN, Maulana Azad Medical College**".
