Applications are invited from Indian nationals for the post of Project Associate-I at IISER Bhopal in the DRDO-funded Research Project "New designs of post-quantum cryptographic candidates".

Project description: The project involves a study of computationally hard mathematical problems relevant to post-quantum cryptography. More specifically, the project aims to study the hard lattice problems and their applications in the design of a digital signature scheme (DSS). The project further seeks to implement a DSS scheme which is post-quantum secure.

Duration: 1 Year, further extendable to the end of the project.

Essential Qualifications:

- 1. BS-MS/M.Sc. in Mathematics or BS-MS/MTech/ME in Computer Science or related disciplines with an excellent academic record. Outstanding candidates with strong CS backgrounds and having BTech/BE or equivalent degrees in any discipline and MSc in Maths and Statistics are also eligible to apply.
- 2. Candidates with experience with computer programming and mathematical aspects of public key cryptography will be preferred.
